

London 2012, Travel Advice for Business

Workshops and Drop-in Sessions for Businesses

The London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games will impact the public transport and road network in certain places at certain times during the Games. For businesses, these events are a huge opportunity - and a major challenge. The Games is likely to impact staff, deliveries and customers.

The Games are fast approaching, with the Olympic Games taking place between 27 July and 12 August and the Paralympic Games from 29 August to 9 September.

To help businesses prepare, a series of workshops and drop-in sessions are available to support businesses across London. Workshops will provide an overview of the transport impacts in your area. Drop-in sessions are also available. Businesses concerned about how they might be affected are encouraged to come along to a workshop or drop-in session.

The workshops last 2 hours and support businesses representatives to prepare their business for the Games. The drop-in sessions are suitable for those that cannot attend a workshop date or for those that would like to speak to a London 2012 representative regarding the likely implications to their business during the Games.
